What is a cash practice?

No Insurance? High Deductible? No Chiropractic benefits? NO PROBLEM!

We are a cash practice which means that we are able to offer services to you at the most economical rate possible. Our experience has been that most insurance companies co-pay is higher than our regular appointment fees. We do not bill insurance for your appointment. On every receipt, you will receive all the codes you need to send into your insurance company to apply to your deductible or if you have chiropractic benefits in your insurance plan, the company will send you a check directly for the amount allowed. It really is as easy as putting a stamp on and mailing!

“Can I use my HSA Account?”

Absolutely! Chiropractic care is a medical expense that is included in health savings accounts.

We are unable to accept Medicare patients at this time but we are in the process of becoming a Medicare non-participating provider.

*We are not able to take Medicaid, Personal Injury liens, or WC. For PI/WC cases, you can submit your paid receipt to your case manager/lawyer for reimbursement at the conclusion of your case but payment in full is due at time of service.

When using a credit card or check you will be asked to provide identification such as a valid driver's license or other form of official proof of identity. This is to protect you due to the many cases of identity theft. PLEASE do not be offended.

If for some reason your check is returned you will incur \$30.00 service charge. You will be asked to bring cash or a money order to cover the amount of the check and the service charge.

Copies of Medical Records

Preparation of forms and copies of medical records require extra office time. Copies of medical records will be available to you to pick up no later than 5 days after we receive the signed release authorization for records and payment for the copies. Preparation and sending of medical records generally costs \$25.00, costs will vary depending on the quantity of records. FMLA and disability forms, as well as camp or sport physicals, and other forms are a minimum of \$10.00 each, even if filled out as a result of an office visit or without an office visit.

If your child needs to see the doctor, a parent or legal guardian must accompany patients who are minors on all of the minor patient's visits. The accompanying adult is responsible for payment at the time of the visit.
